

Resolution passed in the Central Secretariat meeting of BSNL Employees Union, held at New Delhi on 04.09.2018, on the non-implementation of the assurance given by the Hon'ble Minister of State for Communications(IC).

This meeting of the Central Secretariat of BSNL Employees Union, held at New Delhi on 04.09.2018, expressed it's serious concern about the non-implementation of the assurances given by Shri Manoj Sinha ji, Hon'ble Minister of State for Communications(IC), on the important issues connected with the BSNL employees and the Company. In the meeting held with the All Unions and Associations of BSNL (AUAB) on 24.02.2018, the Hon'ble Minister of State for Communications(IC) was kind enough to assure the representatives of the AUAB that, a Cabinet Note would be sent, for the consideration of the Union Cabinet, for getting the 3rd Pay Revision implemented for the BSNL employees. The Hon'ble Minister of State for Communications(IC) was also kind enough to assure that needful action would be taken for the revision of pension of the retired BSNL employees. On the issue of payment of pension contribution by BSNL, the Hon'ble Minister of State for Communications(IC) was kind enough to give direction to the Secretary, Telecom, that pension contribution should be collected from BSNL, only as per the Government of India Rules on the subject. Further, the Hon'ble Minister of State for Communications(IC) assured the delegation of the AUAB that, BSNL would be allotted with 4G spectrum, based on the proposals submitted by the BSNL Management. However, it is very painful to note that even after the lapse of 6 months, no progress is observed with regards to the implementation of the assurances given by the Hon'ble Minister of State for Communications(IC). Further, in the meeting held on 24.02.2018, the Hon'ble Minister of State for Communications(IC) was also kind enough to assure that periodical review meetings could be had with the Secretary, Telecom. However, despite the best efforts taken by the representatives of the AUAB, no meeting has been granted by the Secretary, Telecom, to the representatives of the AUAB. Hence, this meeting fervently appeals to the Hon'ble Minister of State for Communications(IC), to ensure emergent steps, for the early implementation of the assurances given to the representatives of the AUAB, in the meeting held on 24.02.2018.
