Sub: - **Transfer of officials from CGM Office, Hyderabad to CGM Office, Vijayawada, consequent to the bifurcation of circles – req.**

We wish to draw your kind attention to the subject mentioned above.

Consequent to the bifurcation of the erstwhile Andhra Pradesh circle into Telangana and Andhra Pradesh circles, officials from CGM Office, Hyderabad were forcibly transferred to the CGM Office, Vijayawada. Our Union took up the issue with the BSNL Corporate Office and pleaded that these transfers should be avoided, since the families of the transferred officials are getting uprooted, which is causing untold miseries to them. We also gave many alternative proposals for manning the newly formed CGM Office at Vijayawada, without forcibly transferring officials from the CGM Office, Hyderabad. Unfortunately, our proposals were brushed aside by the Corporate Office.

Recently, a third batch of 10 officials were transferred from the CGM Office, Hyderabad to the CGM Office, Vijayawada. Since, this being the end of the academic year, we requested the Director (HR) to kindly retain the officials at Hyderabad itself till 31st May, 2018. The Director (HR) has been kind enough to accept our demand, and the officials are retained till the above mentioned date.

Under these circumstances, it is brought to our notice by our Telangana circle union that shortage of staff has arisen in the CGM Office, Hyderabad. It has also been brought to our notice that, to cope with this shortage, officials are being brought on deputation to the CGM Office, from the Hyderabad Telecom District, as well as from other SSAs of Telangana circle. In this given circumstance, naturally the question arises whether it is justified to forcibly transfer 10 officials (under the 3rd batch) from CGM Office, Hyderabad, to the CGM Office, Vijayawada.

In view of the foregoing, may we request your good self to revisit the issue of sending the 10 officials of the 3rd batch, to the CGM Office, Hyderabad. In view of the shortage being experienced in the CGM Office, Hyderabad, we request you to kindly review the transfer orders of the 10 officials and to kindly retain them at CGM Office, Hyderabad.
