Sub: - Submitting additional item for the Formal Meeting - req.

Ref: - BSNLEU letter no.BSNLEU/211(Formal Meeting) dated 20.05.2022.

We wish to submit that, BSNLEU, vide it's letter cited under reference, had already requested for Formal Meeting. The agenda items to be discussed in the meeting are also given in the aforementioned letter.

In this connection, we request that the following item may also kindly be included in the agenda, as an additional item.

Non-declaration of the results of the JTO LICE conducted in Punjab circle.

The issue of non-declaration of the results of the JTO LICE (50% quota), held in Punjab circle on 26.05.2019, is still unresolved, as a result of which the affected candidates are completely frustrated and demoralised. BSNLEU had already discussed this issue with the Director (HR) many times, including in the Formal Meetings held with him in January, 2020, August, 2020 and in June, 2021. However, the problem is still lingering on. It is needless to state that, this problem is the creation of the Punjab circle administration, initially by conducting the JTO LICE on 26.05.2019, without carrying forward the unfilled vacancies of the previous exam and subsequently making contradictory statements in the court, regarding implementation of reservation to SC/ST employees. The affected employees of Punjab circle complain that the case keeps on going in the court indefinitely, only due to the indifference of the Punjab circle administration. For instance, the Hon'ble CAT, Chandigarh Branch, had issued a direction to BSNL, to reply to Misc. Application No.060/2161/2021, filed by Shri Anil Kumar and others. This direction was given on 12.10.2021. However, the Punjab circle administration has still not complied with the court direction. It is being bitterly complained by the affected candidates that, it is this indifferent attitude of the Punjab circle administration due to which the case is getting dragged on in the Hon'ble Court. Hence, it is requested that needful intervention may kindly be made by the Corporate Office, for an early resolution of this case.
