BSNL WWCC online meeting held on 7th February, 2026.

An online meeting of the BSNL Working Women's Coordination Committee (BSNLWWCC) was held on 7th February 2026. The meeting was presided over by Com. K. Rama Devi, Vice President (CHQ), and inaugurated by Com. Animesh Mitra, General Secretary.

General Secretary's address.

Com. Animesh Mitra elaborated on the demands of the countrywide General Strike scheduled for 12th February, 2026 and stressed the need for intensive campaigning and proper preparations to ensure its grand success. He also highlighted the importance of organising International Women's Day on 8th March, 2026 in a meaningful manner. Further, he briefed the house about the All India Convention of BSNLWWCC to be held on 28th March, 2026 at Mumbai.

Com. M. Vijayakumar, President and Com. Ganesh Hinghe, Dy. General Secretary, were also present in the online meeting from CHQ and guided the discussion regarding the arrangements for the All India Convention at Mumbai.

Reporting and discussion on the preparations for the All India Convention.

Com. K. N. Jyothilekshmi, All India Convener of BSNLWWCC, welcomed the participants and presented a report on the organisational activities of BSNLWWCC during the period. A total of 15 comrades from 10 circles participated in the meeting and actively contributed to the discussions.


After detailed discussions, it was decided that the All India Convention of BSNLWWCC will be held at Mumbai on 28th March, 2026 from 9.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. The conference hall can accommodate 110 delegates.

Decisions taken.

1. BSNLWWCC will actively participate in the campaign programme to ensure the grand success of the General Strike on 12th February, 2026.
2. The leader to inaugurate the All India Convention will be finalised in consultation with CITU leadership. BSNLEU (CHQ) will finalise the programme and related matters.
3. The organisational position and functioning of BSNLWWCC were reviewed. Circle unions shall conduct circle-level BSNLWWCC meetings prior to the All India Convention at Mumbai.
4. A temporary WhatsApp group will be created to coordinate between CHQ and BSNLWWCC and to monitor day-to-day preparations for the All India Convention.
5. International Women's Day on 8th March, 2026 shall be organised in a befitting and effective manner. Since it is a holiday, arrangements may be made to observe the programme on any suitable day during the same week.
