## ***Decisions of the All India Centre meeting held online on 04.12.2024.***

A meeting of the All India Centre is held online yesterday the 04th December, 2024. Com. Animesh Mitra, President, presided over the meeting. The following issues are discussed and decisions are taken.

### **(1) Review of the “meet the employees campaign”.**

As per the decision of the Kolkata CEC meeting, a “**meet the employees campaign**” is being organised from 25th November, to 06th December, 2024. CHQ has already prepared a pamphlet to be handed over to each and every Non-Executive employee during this “**meet the employees campaign**”. CHQ has printed the pamphlet in English and Hindi and has already despatched it to all the circles. Non-Hindi speaking circles have been requested to translate and print the pamphlet in sufficient numbers.

Implementation of this campaign is reviewed in yesterday’s meeting, based on the inputs received from various circles. The meeting expressed it’s dissatisfaction over the implementation of the campaign, since it is not being implemented effectively. In most of the circles, the campaign has been conducted in some areas. Whereas, some circles have not even started implementing this campaign. The All India Centre has appealed to all the circle unions to implement the campaign effectively, by meeting each and every Non-Executive employee and explaining them about the issues contained in the pamphlet. It should also be ensured that, the CHQ pamphlet reaches the hands of each and every Non-Executive employee, irrespective of which union they belong to. In order to ensure the success of this campaign, the All India Centre has extended the last date of the “**meet the employees campaign**” to 17th December, 2024.

### **(2) 11th All India Conference.**

The All India Centre took the decision to conduct the 11th All India Conference of BSNLEU in July, 2025. Considering the fact that the South West Monsoon will be active throughout the country in the month of July, it is decided to request the Tamil Nadu and Chennai circle unions to host the 11th All India Conference. The meeting also decided to conduct an online Central Executive Committee meeting on 12.01.2025 and finalise all the details connected with the 11th All India Conference.

### **(3) Birth centenary of Com.Moni Bose.**

Com.Moni Bose is the former General Secretary of All India Telecom Employees Union (Class-III), and one of the illustrious leaders of the Telecom Trade Union movement. After the untimely death of Com.K.G. Bose in 1974, it was Com.Moni Bose who carried forward the ideology and legacy of Com.K.G. Bose in the Telecom Trade Union movement. Despite dismissal from service very early, Com.Moni Bose continued to dedicate his entire life for strengthening the Telecom Trade Union movement and for the betterment of the lives of the telecom employees. The birth centenary of this great leader falls on 15th May, 2025. The All India Centre meeting decided to celebrate the birth centenary of Com.Moni Bose in a befitting manner. West Bengal circle union has volunteered to organise the birth centenary celebration of Com.Moni Bose at Kolkata on 15th May, 2025.

### **(4) Pay cut for dharna organised on 27.11.2024.**

As per the call of the Coordination Committee of BSNLEU, AIBDPA and BSNLCCWF, a dharna programme was organised on 27.11.2024, demanding settlement of the most burning problems of wage revision, pension revision and other issues. Surprisingly, the Corporate Office has issued letter on 03.12.2024, directing the Chief General Managers to implement pay cut to the employees who have participated in the dharna. The CHQ has written a detailed letter to the CMD BSNL on 04.12.2024, requesting not to implement pay cut to the employees who participated in the dharna. The All India Centre directed the CHQ to take further needful steps on this issue.
