Sub: - **Non-renewal of MoU with the Canara Bank – seeking your kind intervention for the early renewal of the same - req.**

Ref: - Our letter no.BSNLEU/426(LOAN) dated 18.11.2022.

We wish to draw your kind attention to the following, for favour of necessary action.

Vide letter cited under reference, we have brought to your kind notice that, the MoUs signed by BSNL with the Canara Bank and the Union Bank of India, for the purpose of availing various loans by the employees, have already expired. We have sought the personal intervention of the CMD BSNL, for the early renewal of both the MoUs.

We are greatly thankful that, due to the personal intervention of the CMD BSNL, the MoU between BSNL and the Union Bank of India has since been renewed. A large number of employees are benefitted out of this.

At the same time, we wish to bring to your kind that, the MoU between BSNL and the Canara Bank has not been renewed yet. Since, a large number of BSNL employees are having their accounts in the Canara Bank, non-renewal of BSNL's MoU with it has handicapped our employees from availing various loans from that bank.

We understand that, Canara Bank is unwilling to renew the MoU. This may be due to the fact that, in the past, BSNL has failed to make on time remittance of the EMI dues deducted from the salaries of the employees. This was due to the severe financial crisis experienced by BSNL.

Since the scenario has completely changed now, there is no reason for the Canara Bank to avoid the renewal of it's MoU with BSNL. We feel that, taking up of this issue with the top level Management of Canara Bank will help to resolve the deadlock.

In view of this, we earnestly urge upon you to kindly pay your personal attention to this issue and to take it up with the top level Management of the Canara Bank.
