As already informed, the Working Committee of the CITU has decided to organise an online public meeting on $7^{\rm th}$ November 2020.

This public meeting will commemorate the Great October Revolution and its relevance today; mark the conclusion of Golden Jubilee celebration of CITU, which we could not observe till now due to the lockdown and also the centenary of the formation of the first national trade union centre.

The online meeting will start at 3 pm. It will be presided over by Hemalata, President, CITU. In addition to the President and General Secretary of CITU, who will speak in English and Hindi respectively, five national office bearers of CITU will address the meeting in five different languages – Malayalam, Bengali, Telugu, Tamil, and Kannada, in that order. The national office bearers who will speak in different languages will be E Kareem (Malayalam), Anadi Sahu (Bengali), M Saibabu (Telugu), A Soundararajan (Tamil), and Meenakshi Sundaram (Kannada). Each speech will be of approximately 20-25 minutes.
