Sub: - **Contribution of EPF deduction yet to be deposited with the EPF authority – Case of Odisha Circle**  
**– req.**

Sir,

We wish to bring to your kind notice the serious issue regarding non-deposit of EPF contributions in respect of officials who were converted from GPF to EPF in Odisha Circle.

As you are aware, the matter of conversion from GPF to EPF for these officials was already discussed in the National Council meeting held on 13.01.2025. There are around 80 such officials working in Odisha Circle, including those under GM (CNTx) East, who are performing duties within the Odisha Circle jurisdiction. As per the guidelines issued by the Corporate Office, these officials were converted from GPF to EPF, and their EPF deductions have already commenced from their salaries.

However, it is learnt that the department has not yet deposited the deducted EPF amount, including the employer's share, with the EPF authorities. As per rules, the department must deposit both the employee and employer contributions with effect from 01.01.2000 or from the date of their joining as RM. It is also understood that some officials have not yet received their GPF accumulation from DoT.

In view of the above, we request you to kindly issue necessary instructions to the Odisha Circle administration to remit the EPF contributions to the EPF authorities with effect from 01.10.2000. Non-deposit of these contributions will adversely affect the service period and ultimately result in a reduced EPF pension for these officials.

We request your urgent intervention in this matter and look forward to early and favourable action.
