Sub: - Request for implementing revised DCRG for BSNL absorbed DoT employees w.e.f 1.1.2016 – Req.

This is to request your kind intervention for settling the issue mentioned in the subject above.

The DoP&T issued orders on revision of pensionary benefits for Central Government pensioners, based on the recommendations of the 7th CPC, vide its O.M.No. 38/37/2016-P&PW(A)(i) dated 4.8.2016. As per these orders, the ceiling limit for payment of DCRG was enhanced from Rs 10 lakhs to Rs 20 lakhs. The rates of Gratuity were also revised. These revised ceiling and rates are effective from 1.1.2016. The rates of ex gratia lump sum compensation in case of death while on duty/due to terrorists etc were also revised.


Such benefits have to be implemented in the case of DoT employees absorbed in BSNL. But no orders were issued by DoT in this regard. In this connection, it is to inform that even though by that time the wage revision orders effective from 1.1.2007 for the DoT employees absorbed in BSNL (non-executives) were not issued (these orders were issued only on 7.5.2010), the DoT issued an order vide its letter No. 40-31/2008-Pen(T) dated 15.5.2009 allowing the revised rules for pension calculation as per the 6th CPC with regard to DCRG, Commutation table, emoluments, qualifying service etc would be applicable to IDA pensioners of BSNL covered under rule 37-A, w.e.f. 1.1.2006.

It is therefore requested to kindly intervene so that similar orders are issued by DoT for implementing the benefits of such revisions as per the 7<sup>th</sup> CPC report, to the IDA pensioners of BSNL, w.e.f. 01.01.2016.

We shall be thankful for an immediate action in this regard.
