Sub: - **Deadlock prevailing in the reconstitution of the Uttarakhand circle council – requesting to issue necessary guideline to the CGM, Uttarakhand circle - reg.**

Madam,

With reference to the letter cited above, we wish to bring the following to your kind notice, for favour of information and necessary action.

The CGM, Uttarakhand circle, vide letter cited under reference, has written letter to the Corporate Office, seeking guideline to solve the deadlock prevailing in the reconstitution of the Uttarakhand circle council. BSNLEU has already submitted it's nominees for the circle council, while NFTE has so far not submitted it's circle council nominees. We presume that, NFTE is not interested in the formation of the circle council in Uttarakhand circle.

It is needless for us to mention that, more than 2 ½ years have already elapsed after the last Membership Verification is conducted. BSNLEU, the Main Recognised trade union is unable to discuss serious and important staff problems with the Uttarakhand circle management, due to the non-availability of the platform of circle council.

You will agree that, none of the two Recognised trade unions can hijack the circle council, due to their narrow mindedness. If a deadlock is created by any of the two Recognised trade unions, then the onus lies on the Management, to clear the deadlock and ensure formation of the circle council.

***In view of this, we strongly demand that, the Management should go ahead and reconstitute the circle council in Uttarakhand circle, even if any one of the Recognised trade union refuses to submit it's nominees for the circle council.***

We also request that, pending reconstitution of the circle council, the CGM, Uttarakhand circle, may kindly be directed to grant Formal Meeting (Agenda meeting) to BSNLEU, within the shortest possible time, since a lot of important staff issues await discussion and resolution.

We request you to kindly issue necessary guideline to the CGM, Uttarakhand circle, on both the issues, viz., reconstitution of the circle council and granting of Formal Meeting to BSNLEU.
