Sub: - **Non-holding of the meeting of the Joint Committee for Wage Revision – requesting to take action for holding the meeting expeditiously- req.**

Ref: - **BSNLEU letter no.BSNLEU/422(WAGE) dated 06.01.2025.**

Madam,

We wish to bring the following to your kind notice for favour of information and necessary action.

The last meeting of the Joint Committee for Wage Revision was held on 19th December, 2024. After in depth discussions, the following two decisions are taken in this meeting:-

- (1) The Staff Side would submit live stagnation cases based on 5% fitment. The last date for submitting the live cases was decided as 30.12.2024.
- (2) Based on the live cases submitted by the Staff Side, an informal discussion would be held between the Staff Side and the Management Side to scrutinise the live cases submitted by the Staff Side.

Based on the above decisions, the Staff Side submitted 90 live cases of stagnation to Shri Saurabh Tyagi, Chairman of the Joint Committee for Wage Revision, on 23.12.2024 itself. Thereafter, informal discussion between the Staff Side and the Management Side, to scrutinise the correctness of the live cases, was held on 09.01.2025.

Since the decisions taken in the Joint Committee for Wage Revision, held on 19.12.2024, are already implemented the Management ought to have fixed the next meeting of the Joint Committee for Wage Revision promptly. However, it is unfortunate that, holding of this meeting is getting delayed unnecessarily. In this connection, BSNLEU has already written letter to the Director (HR), vide reference cited above, requesting to convene the meeting of the Joint Committee for Wage Revision expeditiously.

In view of the foregoing, we request you to kindly look into the matter and to take action for holding the meeting of the Joint Committee for Wage Revision without further delay.
