Sub: **Reversion from JTO to JE Cadre – Representation of Shri S. Ramakrishna, JTO, AP Circle – req.**

Sir,

We would like to draw your kind attention to the appeal submitted by Shri S. Ramakrishna, JTO, HRMS No. 200303284, AP Telecom Circle, regarding his request for reversion to the JE cadre.

The official joined BSNL as a TTA in 2003 and was later selected as JTO through the LICE-2012. He was posted in AP circle on promotion to the JTO cadre on 01.10.2014. Subsequently, on 01.09.2017, the official had submitted a request for reversion to the TTA cadre. However, this request was not considered in due time, for reasons best known to the department.

Meanwhile, the official was granted time-bound upgradation from E-1 to E-2 with effect from 25.07.2023. At present, he is facing serious family problems and has again submitted a fresh representation on 22.07.2024 seeking reversion to the JE cadre. He has clearly stated his willingness to refund the amount received due to the time-bound upgradation, as well as any training-related expenditure, if required.

The Circle Administration has already forwarded the case to the Corporate Office, with a request to relax the existing rule which states that “reversion to the parent cadre can be considered only if the employee has not completed two years of service in the promoted post.”

Sir, this is a case that deserves sympathetic and humanitarian consideration. The official has voluntarily expressed readiness to step down to the basic cadre and to refund all related financial benefits received. We earnestly request you to consider his appeal with a practical and compassionate approach, so that the official may continue his service with mental peace.
