Sub: - **Special concession to Central Government / PSU employees, working in Kashmir Valley – requesting to endorse the DoP&T letter - req.**

With reference to the letter cited above, we wish to draw your kind attention to the subject mentioned above.

The DoP&T, vide it's letter number cited under reference (1), has extended the package of concessions / incentives to Central Government employees working in Kashmir Valley, for a further period from 01.01.2020 to 31.07.2021. It is further mentioned in the letter that, this package of incentives is uniformly applicable to all Ministries / Departments and PSUs under the Government of India.

The DoT, vide it's letter number cited under reference (2), has also endorsed the extension of the package of concessions / incentives. BSNLEU, vide it's letter cited under reference (3), addressed to the Sr.GM(Estt.) in the Corporate Office, has demanded that the order of the DoP&T should immediately be implemented to the BSNL employees posted in the Kashmir Valley.

However, it is regrettable to note that, the Corporate Office has so far not taken any action to implement the letters of the DoP&T and the DoT, for the payment of concessions and incentives. We wish to also bring to your kind notice that, the BSNL employees posted in the Kashmir Valley are serving under extremely hostile and difficult conditions. Hence, delaying the payment of concessions / incentives, as envisaged in the DoP&T letter is undesirable.

In view of the foregoing, we request you to kindly get the matter looked into, so that our brothers and sisters posted in Kashmir Valley are not denied justice, under the pretext of paucity of funds. Copies of all the letters cited under reference are enclosed for your kind perusal.
