Sub: - **Submitting additional items for the Formal Meeting to be held with BSNLEU - req.**

We request you to kindly consider to include the following item, for discussion in the forthcoming Formal Meeting with BSNLEU.

Holding the JE LICE as an offline exam.

BSNLEU has been insisting from the very beginning that, all LICEs for promotion from one Non-Executive cadre to another Non-Executive cadre, should be conducted only offline. This is mainly because, the Non-Executives belonging to cadres like TT, ATT, etc., do not have access to computers in their day to day works. Hence, these sections of the Non-Executives are not familiar with computer operations. On account of this, they will be facing great difficulty to appear in the online LICEs.

This issue was also raised in the 37th meeting of the National Council, held on 20.11.2018, by the General Secretary of BSNLEU. It was strongly demanded in that meeting that, "All LICE exams from Non-Executive posts to Non-Executive posts should be conducted only as offline exams." The Chairperson of the National Council responded positively to this demand and assured that, the Management would consider holding offline LICEs for promotions from one Non-Executive cadre to another Non-Executive cadre.

Despite all these, the Recruitment Branch is now insisting to hold the JE LICE as an online exam. Those who are going to appear in the JE LICE are the Non-Executives belonging to the cadres of Assistant Telecom Technician(ATT), Telecom Technician(TT), etc., who are not familiar with computer operations. Hence, we strongly demand that, the JE LICE should only be held as an offline exam.
