Sub: - Holding of the TT LICE under 50% quota for the vacancy years 2020 & 2021 - non-availability of vacancies in many circles - requesting to take needful action - reg.

Ref: - BSNL letter no.BSNLCO-11/13(14)/1/2022-RECTT-CO dated 02.02.2023.

With reference to the letter cited above, we would like to bring the following to your kind notice, for favour of necessary action.

You are aware that, BSNLEU had long been urging upon the Management to hold all the LICEs of the Non-Executives, including the Telecom Technician LICE. Now, the Recruitment Branch of the Corporate Office, vide letter cited under reference, has directed the CGMs of 15 circles, to hold the TT LICE under 50% quota, for the vacancy years of 2020 & 2021.

We are anguished to note that, this TT LICE is going to be held only in the circles of A&N, Chhattisgarh, Kolkata Telephones, Gujarat, Haryana, Kerala, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Punjab, Rajasthan, UP (West), Telangana and Uttarakhand. It means, this TT LICE for the vacancy years of 2020 & 2021 is not going to be held in 14 circles viz., Assam, Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Chennai Telephones, Himachal Pradesh, NE-I, NE-II, Tamil Nadu, West Bengal, Jharkhand, Sikkim, J&K, UP(East) and NTR.

It is needless for us to state that, the TT LICE is not conducted for the past so many years. As such, the letter cited under reference, denying opportunity to the candidates of the aforementioned 14 circles, has demoralised the TT LICE aspirants. The Management is well aware that, a large number of candidates belonging to the cadres of Assistant Telecom Technician, etc., are languishing in stagnation for the past so many years. As such, ensuring holding of the TT LICE in all the circles, would have given an opportunity for such employees to overcome the problem of stagnation. It is highly regrettable that, the Management has shut down the doors for this in 14 circles.

Time and again, BSNLEU has already brought to the notice of the Management that, the posts sanctioned under the Restructuring Process, in respect of various cadres, including the Telecom Technician cadre, are highly insufficient and do not meet the field level requirements. Thus, there is an urgent need to review the norms fixed for various cadres, under the Restructuring Process.

In view of the foregoing, we fervently appeal to you to kindly revisit the issue and to take appropriate action for making sufficient Telecom Technician posts available in all the aforementioned 14 circles also, for the forthcoming TT LICE to be held for the vacancy years 2020 & 2021.
