Sub: - **Correction in date of effect in Presidential Order – case of Maharashtra circle – req.**

Sir,

It has come to our notice that, some candidates in Maharashtra circle are suffering to get the pensionary benefit even after successful completion of service life. As the candidates were in TSM cadre in DoT period, the Presidential Order was issued by the Corporate Office in due time. I would like to refer the particular case of Shri Khandve Shivaji Gulab, TT of Maharashtra circle, who had retired from the department on 31st May, 2025. But, the settlement of pension case is being halted by the CCA Office, MH circle, on the plea for correction the date of permanent absorption which has mentioned as 01.10.2000. In fact, the official was regularised as TM and the Presidential Order for his absorption in BSNL was issued on 23.01.2008. But, the date of effect for his permanent absorption was mentioned in the PO letter as 01.10.2000 though the official was regularised as a TT on 01.09.2002. A similar case has also can be mentioned that Shri Mohanlal M. Yadao, retired Telecom Technician, staff of Wardha (Chandrapura BA), is also suffering due to the same problem.

The circle administration has taken up the issue with the CCA authority, Maharashtra circle. Recently, the circle administration has also forwarded the case to the Corporate Office to get the clarification and guideline also for the correction of the date of absorption in PO letter of the above mentioned officials. We would request you to take necessary action in this regard so that the officials can get their pensionary benefit without further delay.
