

## **Conclusions of the UIS General Council Meeting - TPPC**

On Wednesday, December 15, 2021, the last Virtual Meeting of the General Council of the International Union of Transport, Ports, Fisheries and Communication Trade Unions (UIS - TPPC) was held.

The meeting began with a welcome, greeting and introduction to the meeting by our Secretary General, Cro. Ali Riza K.

Only 12 members of the management participated in this meeting, we are concerned about the absence of the rest of the management of our organization.

The meeting was carried out in a very orderly manner, with active participation, we want to thank all those who provided the information on the work carried out in 2021 in their countries and the regions of America and Europe.

### **Conclusions:**

- It is agreed to hold a virtual meeting of the UIS Directorate in February 2022.
- Meetings with members of the General Council will be coordinated to learn about the readiness for the work of the TUI in their countries and regions.
- A face-to-face meeting of the Directorate of the UIS - TPPC is required, in the first semester of 2022, the possibility that it could be in Syria, Europe or America was expressed. The above also in coordination with the date of the 18th WFTU World Congress.
- Each member of the UIS leadership must make a proposal on the 2022 action plan for the next meeting of the general council - UIS. It is important to send it in English, Spanish, French and Portuguese, if possible.
- It is also agreed that for the months of January and February 2022, coordination must be made to establish the Regional Secretaries for Africa, the Middle East and Asia.
- It is necessary to strengthen the Europe Regional Secretariat and the Americas Region Federation - FUTAC.
- In relation to the 18th WSF World Congress, it is agreed that we will make every effort to be present with an important delegation from the TUI.
- Solidarity:
- It is agreed to show solidarity with Syria, its people, the working class and its government.
- Solidarity with transport drivers, on the border with Jordan.

- The TUI - TPPC must be permanently in solidarity with the struggles of the workers and the peoples, who raise the banners of sovereignty, independence and their self-determination.
- It is agreed to show solidarity with the struggle of the autonomous truckers and band members of Brazil.
- Support and solidarity with the General Strike in India / February 23, 2022
- Support Palestine and propose to the Central Directorate WSF / Boycott against Israel.
- We declare ourselves in permanent solidarity with Cuba, Venezuela, Nicaragua, Bolivia, Syria, Lebanon and Palestine, peoples and governments that fight for their independence, sovereignty, self-determination and the right to build in the society that they want to live and inherit to the new generations.
