Sir,

With reference to our letters cited above, we wish to once again bring to the following to your kind notice, for favour of necessary action.

Many of our employees have taken LIC policy for which they need to pay premium amount. Earlier, this LIC premium was deducted from the salary of the employees and was remitted to the LIC. However, this system has been abruptly discontinued by the Management, which has caused unwarranted inconvenience to the employees. BSNLEU, vide letters cited under reference, has already written to the CMD BSNL, requesting to resume the deduction of LIC premium from the salary of the employees.

It is needless for us to state that, in all Government Departments as well as in Public Sector Companies, the LIC premium of the employees who have taken policy, is being deducted from the salary by the Government / Management and the same is being remitted to LIC. It is important to state here that, LIC is also a Public Sector Company, owned by the Government of India.

In view of the foregoing and also keeping the welfare of the employees into consideration, we request you to kindly resume the deduction of LIC premium from the salary of the employees and remit the same to the LIC.
