Sub: - **Difficulties being faced by the JTO Induction trainees - seeking your kind intervention - req.**

We wish to bring the following to your kind notice, for favour of necessary intervention.

As per the JTO induction training procedure (revised 2022) issued on 9/11/2022, there are totally 8 modules, containing 126 chapters, comprising of nearly 2000 pages and an online JTO Trainee final seniority exam of all JTO (Phase-I) trainees is being conducted at the last day of the training (10 weeks) for 100 marks in 90 minutes, where the qualifying mark is 50%.

A single qualifying examination for the entire training program containing huge chunks of material, may not properly judge the JTO trainee. As per the previous JTO induction training, the exams are module wise and are averaged finally and are conducted by local RTTC.

However, with the introduction of new exam pattern, the JTO trainees are under severe stress in reading and memorizing the huge content. Till now no printed material has been provided. Only soft copies of the material have been given. BSNLEU has already brought this to the notice of the GM(Rectt. &Trng.) But, nothing has happened so far.

The JTO trainees are well qualified, experienced and have passed the tough JTO LICE competitive exam. This type of JTO induction training is creating a huge stress on the young JTO trainees.

In view of the foregoing, we earnestly request to you kindly intervene on this matter and to ensure that, the pressure on the JTO trainees is redressed by taking appropriate measures. In this connection, we once again insist that, supply of printed materials is ensured immediately. Further, the qualifying mark is also reduced from 50% to 35%.
