Sub: - **Show-cause notice issued to the leaders of the Associations of the Executives, for imposing break-in-service under FR 17-A – requesting for early settlement of the case - reg.**

We wish to draw your kind attention to the following, for favour of appropriate action.

Some of the leaders of the Executives' Associations in BSNL, have been issued with show-cause notices, for the imposition of break-in-service under FR 17-A, for the struggle conducted under the banner of the All Unions and Associations of BSNL (AUAB) in February, 2019.

The matter is already discussed with the erstwhile CMD BSNL, Director (HR), as well as with the Additional Secretary, Telecom. Disciplinary actions in BSNL are governed by the CDA Rules. As such, FR 17-A is not applicable to the employees of BSNL. As such, the AUAB has demanded that the notices issued under FR 17-A should be withdrawn.

It is very pertinent to state that, in the presence of the AUAB representatives, the Additional Secretary, Telecom, had instructed the Director (HR), BSNL, to look into the matter and to do the needful. However, the BSNL Management has not withdrawn the above mentioned notices.

We would like to draw your kind attention to the specific case of Shri N.Kabeer Das, JTO, HRMS No.198402373, Staff No.4537, o/o of the SDE, External, Charminar, PGM South, Hyderabad Telecom District. He is the General Secretary of the BSNL OA and has been issued with the notice for imposing break-in-service under FR 17-A. Shri N. Kabeer Das has retired on superannuation on 30.06.2019. Due to the pendency of the notice issued for imposition of break-in-service under FR 17-A, the official's pension case is yet to be settled.

It is needless to state that non-settlement of pension will create extreme hardship to any employee. Hence, considering the gravity of the issue, we request you to kindly look into it and to do the needful for the early withdrawal of the show-cause notice issued to Shri N.Kabeer Das, JTO (retired), and thereby to cause the settlement of his pension.

Further, we also request you to kindly do the needful for the early withdrawal of the notices, issued to the other leaders of the Associations of the Executives also, for imposing break-in-service under FR 17-A. Your kind action in this regard would go a big way in improving industrial peace in BSNL.
