Sub: - **Requesting to grant extension of time for retention of staff quarters by retired employees and requesting to exempt them from the rent hike - req.**

**(2) BSNLEU letter no.BSNLEU/516(QTRS) dated 15.09.2020.**

With reference to the letter cited above, we wish to bring the following to your kind notice for favour of necessary action.

A large number of employees, who are occupying the staff quarters, have retired under VRS w.e.f. 31.01.2020. In addition to this, many employees occupying the staff quarters, have also retired under superannuation. It has been brought to our notice that, many occupants of the quarters, who have already retired under VRS or under superannuation, are unable to find a rented house, in this COVID-19 pandemic situation.

In view of this, we have already written to you, vide letter cited under reference (1), requesting to extend the period of retention of the quarters, by retired employees. However, we regret to state that, neither the Management has issued any letter to mitigate the sufferings of the retired employees occupying the quarters, nor has it given any reply to the Union.

Likewise, BSNLEU has also written to you, vide letter cited under reference (2), drawing your kind attention to the sufferings of the retired employees who are occupying the quarters, due to the exorbitant hike in the rent. In this case also, BSNLEU has written to you, requesting to reconsider the increase in the rent, as a token of recognition of the contributions of the retired employees to the growth of the Company. In this case also, neither the Management has revisited the issue, nor has it given any reply to the Union.

In view of the foregoing, we request you to kindly cause to issue necessary instruction to permit the retired employees to retain the staff quarters for six months, beyond the normal retention period.

Further, we also request you to kindly exempt the retired employee from the rent hike, as a token of recognition of their contributions for the growth of the Company. We earnestly request you to kindly consider our requests.
