Sub: - **JTO(OL) LICE held in February, 2024- requesting to consider posting the willing qualified candidates in other circles where posts remain unfilled - reg.**

Sir,

We wish to bring the following to your kind notice for favour of necessary action.

As per the Restructuring of Manpower, the Management had announced that, 51 posts are available in the JTO (OL) cadre. The JTO (OL)LICE was held on 04-02-2024 and 09-02-2024. However, this examination was conducted for filling up 37 posts of JTO (OL) only. We strongly feel that, the JTO (OL) LICE should have been conducted for all the available 51 posts.

It is relevant to mention here that, the Parliamentary Committee on Official Language, has time and again underscored the need to fill up all the available Hindi Officers' posts, in various PSUs and Central Government Departments.

Furthermore, we learn that, out of the 37 posts declared for the JTO (OL) LICE, only 22 posts have been filled up. In some circles, candidates have got qualified in the JTO(OL)LICE, however, there is no post available to promote them. In some other circles, posts are available, but sufficient number of candidates have not qualified. This must be the reason why 15 JTO(OL) posts remain unfilled.

Now, certain candidates who have got qualified in the JTO(OL) LICE, held in February 2024, but who were not posted as JTO(OL), due to nonavailability of vacancies in their circle, have expressed their willingness to get posted in other circles where JTO(OL) posts remain unfilled.

We feel that, the Management should consider their request. It is learnt that, certain candidates have already given their representations to the Management, expressing their willingness to get posted as JTO(OL) in the circles where posts remain unfilled. Here we need to keep in mind, the recommendation of the Parliamentary Committee on Official Language, which has underscored the need to fill up the available Hindi officers' posts.

In view of the forgoing, we request you to kindly consider the requests of the qualified candidates, who are willing to get posted as JTO(OL) in other circles, where posts remain unfilled.
