Sub: - Issuing of Presidential Orders to the TSMs directly promoted as Telephone Mechanics after 01.10.2000 - req.

Ref: - (i) BSNL letter no.11-1/2015-LE (Part.) dated 16.07.2018.

We would like to urgently attract your kind attention to the following issue, for favour of appropriate action.

The Staff Side of the National Council took up an item in the 32<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the National Council, held on 14.05.2015, regarding issuing of Presidential Orders to such of those TSMs who were directly promoted as Telecom Mechanics, after 01.10.2000. The Staff Side demanded that these officials should also be issued with Presidential Orders, at par with those TSMs who were appointed as Regular Mazdoors, on or after 30.09.2000. It was informed by the Management Side that the circles would be directed to furnish details of such employees. It was also informed that on receipt of information from the circles, necessary action would be taken in consultation with the DoT. It is a matter of regret that, four years have already passed since the matter was raised in the National Council and still it remains unresolved.

You will agree that this issue needs to be resolved emergently, in view of the implementation of VRS-2019. Many of the employees falling under this category, viz., TSMs directly promoted as Telecom Mechanics after 01.10.2000, have also opted for the VRS. Their entitlement to the government pension is in jeopardy, since they are not issued with Presidential Orders. As regards VRS optees, it is an irony that the TSMs who were regularised as RMs are entitled for government pension, whereas TSMs who were promoted to a higher cadre, viz., Telecom Mechanic, are not entitled for government pension.

In view of the urgency of the matter, we earnestly request you to kindly bestow your personal attention for the timely solution of this problem.
