Sub: - **Review of the results of the 50% JE LICE – 2016-17 held on 28.01.2018 – giving full marks for wrong / multiple answers / all options are wrong / out of syllabus - req.**

We wish to draw your kind attention to the subject mentioned above.

The 50% JE LICE – 2016 -17 was conducted on 28.01.2018. The officials with 10+2 qualification are eligible to appear the LICE. Most of the departmental candidates are from Telecom Technicians (TT) who are mainly assigned works like handling outdoor field issues related to cables and wires, look after battery, power plant, wiring in MDF and other sections of our Organisation. Most of the TTAs are not allotted with personal computer, nor they have received any training in CDR related works. However, in this exam, many questions related to CDR have been asked, which does not form part of the syllabus. It is reported by a large number of candidates who appeared in the above stated exam that, many of the questions asked in the examination are of engineering graduate level.


The answers keys made public through internet on 17th February, 2018 and has been sent to the candidates on their registered e-mail ID. While scrutinising the answer key, several discrepancies are observed. It has been noticed that 16 questions in Part A and 5 questions in Part B are found with wrong or with multiple correct answers. 2 questions in Part A and 10 questions in part B are found out of syllabus. Further, questions which are of high standard are = 04, 09, 11, 13, 15, 16, 19, 20, 21, 23, 24, 28, 29, 30, 31, 33, 34 and 38 in Part A.

Candidates have already represented for review of such types of questions. Further, due to incomplete description of exam syllabus, the standard of the paper is so tough that even an engineering graduate would find it difficult to answer the paper.

In view of the foregoing, we request you to kindly intervene in the matter and to ensure to grant full marks to the questions with wrong / multiple answers / all options are wrong / out of syllabus. Further, it is also requested that marks should be given to the questions which are of high standard. We are enclosing details of wrong questions, for your kind perusal.
